Game Capsule Summary

Joe Cox led the host Orfordville Orioles to their first Sunday league victory in Home Talent Baseball. Cox allowed the Evansville Jays only two hits over seven innings and led all hitters with a 4 for 4 day at the plate and 2 rbi and two runs scored. Jamir Crowley backed up Cox with a 3 for 3 performance and three runs scored.

Evansville starter and Cox’s fellow UW-Platteville teammate, Brent Cashore, got himself in real trouble early on by allowing 4 runs on 5 walks and 2 hits in the Orioles’ first inning. Jarmon Crowley, B.J. Cook, and Cox all doubled for Orfordville, with Cox doubling twice. Cook also drove in two runs.

The victory for Orfordville came on the heels of their first Night League victory on Thursday night. The Orioles also beat Evansville that night with a 7-1 win posted by Zach Jones. Jones allowed only three hits and walked two while striking out 9 over six innings. Patrick Moore came on in the 7th inning to get a little mound time and struck out two to finish up the game for Jones.
