**Game Capsule Summary**

The Orfordville Orioles advanced to the semi-finals of the Class B SWABA [Southern Wisconsin Amateur Baseball Association] Tournament on Saturday by edging the Kewaskum A's 4-3 behind the 11 strikeout, complete game pitching effort by Bob Findlay. Findlay allowed only 6 hits over 7 innings while walking just two A's batters.

The Orioles trailed the A's 2-0 through two innings, but added a run in their third when Cris Cartmill doubled to lead off the inning, Trevor Wallace sacrifice bunted him to third, and Nate Henke belted a sacrifice fly to centerfield scoring Cartmill.

The A's put two runs on the board in each of their first two at-bats by using small ball and taking advantage of two Orioles infield errors; the Orioles only errors in the game. Kewaskum notched another run in their 5<sup>th</sup> when Jake Spaeth singled with one out and scored on Jon Olla's double over Patrick Moore's head in leftfield. Olla moved to third on a passed ball, but got no further as Findlay struck out the A's Jason Strobel and coaxed a fly out to rightfield by Brandon Banton to end Kewaskum's threat.

In the bottom of their fourth, Orfordville plated three runs to take the lead at 4-2. Kewaskum's Jim Ziegler walked Joe Cox and Seth Hendricks laid down a two strike back-spin popup between the mound and third base. Ziegler dived for the ball in an attempt to catch Hendricks' bunt in the air and double off Cox. However, Ziegler failed to catch the popup, but touched to ball in fair territory and it bounced away from him toward the third base dugout. Had Ziegler not touched the ball, Hendricks would have been called out on a foul bunt with two strikes, but Hendricks reached safely instead.

With Cox and Hendricks on second and first respectively, Zach Jones sacrifice bunted advancing both runners. Dan Gander then drove a two strike pitch to the opposite field which bounced erratically away from the A's rightfielder allowing Cox and Hendricks to score and Gander to reach third base. Gander scored later on a sacrifice fly to deep center by Trevor Wallace.

The A's were able to get a runner as far as second base in their 6<sup>th</sup>, but the threat ended when Orioles shortstop Cartmill took a grounder up the middle and turned a double play.

The Orioles will face Neosho Rockets in the SWABA semi-finals on July 11<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 pm in Horicon. Neosho advanced by eliminating Mayville on Saturday.
