Game Capsule Summary

The Orfordville Orioles' Bob Findlay and the Neosho Rockets' Dusty Jacobson locked up in a proverbial pitchers' duel Wednesday night in the semi-finals of the Southern Wisconsin Amateur Baseball Association [SWABA] in Horicon, Wisconsin. Orfordville edged Neosho 3-2 and will advance to the 9 inning championship game against the host team Horicon on Friday, July 20th at 8:30 pm. The Horicon Honkers beat the Monches Irish 4-0 in the first game on Wednesday night.

Findlay prevailed due in large part to his 11 strikeouts and 4 hits scattered through 8 innings. Findlay walked four Rockets, one of which scored in the bottom of the 6th for Neosho's first run of the game. Jacobson struck out 7 Orioles, allowed only 5 hits and walked two in his complete game effort.

Neosho tied the game at 2-2 in the bottom of the 7th with a one out double to left and a two out bloop single over third base. The Orioles' Nate Henke snagged a dying liner off the grass to third base to end the Rockets' threat.

Orfordville scored their winning tally in the 8th when B.J. Cook led off with a single and then advanced to third base on a muffed pick off throw to first base. Patrick Moore walked and Joe Cox was safe on a fielder's choice to load the bases. Seth Hendricks topped a grounder toward the hole at third which was bobbled, allowing Cook to score. Neosho's Jacobson struck out Dan Gander after an 8 pitch at bat. Still with the bags loaded, Cris Cartmill drove a liner toward the gap in shallow right center which was caught preventing Moore from scoring. Nate Tilley then hit a soft liner just within reach of the first baseman to end the Orioles' threat in the 8th. Findlay retired the last three Neosho hitters in order in the bottom of the 8th to secure the Orfordville victory.

Schedule / Changes:
