Game Capsule Summary

The Orfordville Orioles blasted out 16 hits against the host Whitewater Swingers in Home Talent baseball enroute to an 8-5 victory on Sunday. With the win, the Orioles improved their Sunday league record to 6-7. Whitewater dropped to 3-8.

The Swingers got off to an early lead, scoring two runs off starter Mike Toubl in their half of the first frame. Toubl was making his first start on the mound since 2003 and struggled with his control. Joe Cox was summoned to relieve him in the first and pitched the rest of the way to earn the win.

Whitewater took the lead 4-3 in their 6th when with two outs, Cox drilled David Lynch in the kneecap. Andy Hummel singled to move Lynch to second after which Cox tried to pick off Hummel as he wandered off first base. The pickoff throw went wildly down the first base line which allowed both runners to advance to scoring position. Whitewater's starting pitcher Jason Kollwelter wasted no time in helping his own cause as he drove a single to left plating both runners and giving his team a 4-3 lead.

Kollwelter shut down the Orioles' offense in the top of the 7th, but the Orioles plated three runs in their 8th when Cox led off with a double to the gap in right center. Aaron Laursen and Zach Jones followed with back to back singles with Jones' single scoring Cox to tie the game. Cris Cartmill bunted Laursen and Jones to third and second respectively and Kevin Risseeuw drove in Laursen with a single up the middle. Trevor Wallace hit an rbi slow grounder to second scoring Jones and giving the Orioles a 6-4 lead.

Whitewater scored a run in their 8th when after a lead off walk, a hit batter, and a single to left field to load the bases, Kollwelter drove a fly ball to left. The Orioles tried to double up Whitewater's Lynch as he was caught trying to advance on the fly out and the throw went past the bag at second, allowing the runner at third to score. Cox coaxed the next hitter into a pop up in front of the plate to retire the side.

Orfordville added two more runs in their 9th as B.J. Cook singled to lead off and Cox reached on an infield error. Laursen grounded to second advancing Cook and Cox. Jones then singled to right with his 4th single of the game and his 2nd rbi to plate Cook. Risseeuw then drove another single up the middle for his third hit and 2nd rbi of the game to score Cox and give the Orioles an 8-5 lead.

The Orioles grabbed their first lead of the game 3-2 in the 5th when Seth Hendricks drove a bases loaded double to deep center to clear the bases.

New bright spots in the Orioles offense were Zach Jones with a 4 for 4 day at the plate and two rbi and Kevin Risseeuw with a three for 5 day and two rbi. Hendricks was the game rbi leader with three.
