**Game Capsule Summary**

The Orfordville Orioles fell to the division-leading Albion Tigers 12-7 on Wednesday at Edgerton's Racetrack Park in Home Talent Sunday league baseball action. It was the Orioles' first loss in their last six outings overall and their Sunday record now stands at 4-7.

Coming back from a 6-1 deficit, Orfordville tied the Tigers at 6-6 in the top of the 7<sup>th</sup> inning, but couldn't hold the Albion offense as it batted around against Orioles reliever Seth Hendricks, and added another 5 runs in the bottom of the 7<sup>th</sup>.

Hendricks relieved starter Zach Jones in the 5<sup>th</sup> inning with runners on 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> and one out and Albion's Kris Agnew coming to the plate. Agnew had homered in the 2<sup>nd</sup> to give the Tigers their first lead of the game. Hendricks allowed him an rbi single, but then retired the next two batters to end the Tigers' threat in the 5<sup>th</sup>. Orfordville closed the gap to 6-3 in their 6<sup>th</sup> with three consecutive singles by B.J. Cook, Patrick Moore, and Joe Cox off Tigers' starter Ben Everson. Cox drove in Cook and Moore scored on an infield groundout by Aaron Laursen.

Hendricks shut down the Albion offense in the 6<sup>th</sup>, allowing only one base runner. Hendricks was called upon to make his first relief appearance of the season due to a depleted Orioles pitching staff.
