Game Capsule Summary

Kevin Risseeuw made his first start of the season memorable as he pitched his Orfordville Oriole teammates to a 7-1 Home Talent Night League victory over Pine Bluff, striking out 14, walking none, and yielding only two hits in a 7 inning complete game performance. Orfordville blew the game open in the 4th inning, scoring 6 runs on 5 hits which overcame a 1-0 deficit after three innings. Highlighting the 4th inning were a 2 run double by Nate Henke (his 2nd double of the night) and a 2 rbi single by Orioles' catcher Aaron Budha Laursen. Laursen drove in three runs on the night.

Risseeuw limited the Bluffers to two hits in the 1st inning and allowed Pine Bluff to score on a wild pitch. He then struck out the next two batters to retire the side, stranding a runner on third base. Pine Bluff never saw a runner get past 1st base the balance of the game as Risseeuw settled into a groove, throwing 65 strikes against 29 balls.

The Orioles remain unbeaten in Night League play with a 4-0 record.

The Orioles travel to Monches, Wisconsin (Waukesha area) on Saturday to take on the Kewaskum A's from the Rock River League in the first round of the Class B SWABA (Southern Wisconsin Amateur Baseball Association) tournament at 4 pm.
