### Game Capsule Summary

The Orfordville Orioles scored three runs in their half of the 6<sup>th</sup> to regain an 8-5 lead over the host Monroe Brewers and go on to take a 9-6 victory in Home Talent Night League action.

Monroe had tied the game at 5-5 in their half of the 4<sup>th</sup> inning when Orioles' starter Zach Jones developed control problems and after yielding a lead off double to Scott White, walked three batters and walked in a run. Monroe's Shawn Dasher then delivered a double to the left center field gap which scored two more runs. Orfordville manager Jan Toubl called upon Patrick Moore to relieve Jones. Moore responded and struck out Justin Hahn but the ball was dropped on strike three. The Orioles played on Hahn to get the out at first, but meanwhile Dasher danced home to knot the score at 5 all.

The Orfordville offense responded in the top of the 5<sup>th</sup> when B.J. Cook lead off with a drive down the third baseline for a double, and after a base hit by Joe Cox, scored on a hit by Andy Risseeuw. With runners on first and second, Zach Jones sacrifice bunted both runners into scoring position. Cris Cartmill drove an 0-2 pitch to the left center field gap scoring both Cox and Risseeuw.

Orfordville added another run in their 6<sup>th</sup> when Trevor Wallace walked to lead off the inning, advanced to second base on an infield grounder and scored on a Cook single improving the score to 9-5.

The Brewers managed to plate another run in the bottom of the 7<sup>th</sup> when Moore allowed a single and a double after two outs. Mike Cleary plated Lon Scheuerell with a base hit making the score 9-6. Moore then struck out the next batter on three straight pitches.

The Orioles got on the board right away in their 1<sup>st</sup> when Nate Henke belted a two run home run with no outs. Monroe had four doubles on the night provided by Scott White, Shawn Dasher, Justin Hahn, and Adam Sigenthaler.
