Game Capsule Summary

Verona knotted the Home Talent South Night League standings at 5-1 with the Orfordville Orioles as they prevailed to win 12-9 in a 30-hit slugfest Tuesday night at Purdy Park. Each team had 15 hits, but Verona was lead by A.J. Stoffels 4 for 5 night, including a two run homer in the 4th off Orioles' starter Kevin Risseeuw. Stoffels had 6 rbi to highlight his performance for Verona.

Zach Jones and Seth Hendricks paced the Orioles' hitting attack as they each collected 3 hits in 4 at bats, with Jones doubling in the 2nd inning.

Verona took an early 3-0 lead in the 2nd, highlighted by a two run single by playing manager Dale Burgenske. They added another run in the 3rd when Zach Spencer belted the first pitch by Risseeuw to the right center field gap. He scored on a single by Nick Krohn.

Orfordville picked up two runs in their 3rd when Nate Henke singled with two outs, advanced to second on a walk to Joe Cox, and scored on a single by B.J. Cook. Cook advanced to third on a muffed groundball by Patrick Moore which scored Cox. With runners on the corners and two outs and Moore attempting to steal second base, Cook was caught in a run down and tagged out.

Verona answered back in their 4th with two more runs highlighted by Stoffels' home run. With the score at 6-2, the Orioles responded in their 4th with two more runs off Verona's starter Dan Koss. The Orioles managed to load the bases off Koss as Jones and Hendricks both singled and Aaron Laursen walked. Kevin Risseeuw then topped a pitch down the third base line which the pitcher fielded and tagged Jones out trying to score. Then with two outs and the bases still loaded, Henke coaxed an rbi walk and Cox followed with an rbi single to left.

Risseeuw struck out the first batter in the 5th, but things got dicey after that as he walked two and allowed a base hit to load the bases. Risseeuw then yielded an rbi walk to Koss to make the score 7-4. Moore came on to pitch for Orfordville, but gave up a bases clearing double to Stoffels. Then after yielding another single, Moore settled down and struck out the next batter followed by an infield groundout to strand two runners and end the Verona threat.

With the Orioles down 10-4, Verona called on the usually reliable pitching arm of Nick Krohn. Orfordville greeted Krohn by batting around in the 5th and scoring 5 runs highlighted by a disputed 3 run opposite field double down the line by Cox.

Moore retired the side in order in the 6th, but Verona moved ahead 12-9 in their 7th courtesy of a double and two singles. In the bottom of the 7th, Orfordville managed to get two runners on base, but Krohn then retired the next three Orioles to end the game.

Schedule / Changes:

The Orioles (5-1 N/L) will travel to Verona (5-1 N/L) on Thursday to face Wildcat Lanes again at 7:30 pm on the Verona High School field. First place in the South Night League will be on the line.

Note: Verona is undefeated in Home Talent Sunday League play and leads the Western Section.
