### **Game Capsule Summary**

The visiting Orfordville Orioles squeaked out a 5-4 Night League victory Tuesday night over the Evansville Jays in an 11 inning Home Talent Baseball game at Lake Leota Park. Jarod Steindl singled to lead off the Jays' 9<sup>th</sup>, moved to second on a sacrifice bunt, and attempted to score the winning run but was cut down at the plate on a one hop throw by Orioles' right fielder B.J. Cook to the Orioles' catcher Seth Hendricks. Evansville's Ryan Lindemann had singled to the opposite field down the right field line in what appeared to be the game-winning hit. Cook hastened to the ball as it corkscrewed away from him, but he turned and fired a strike to Hendricks who blocked the plate, tagging Steindl out, and saving the Orioles from a Night League defeat.

Orioles' reliever Patrick Moore allowed a lead off walk in the bottom of the 11<sup>th</sup>, but was able to settle in and retire the next three batters to end the game.

The Orioles took the lead in their 11<sup>th</sup> after Zach Jones singled through the hole to right field, and moved over to 2<sup>nd</sup> on Hendricks' sacrifice bunt. Cris Cartmill single to push Jones over to 3<sup>rd</sup>. Kevin Risseuw then singled to score Jones easily and give the Orioles their 5-4 winning margin.

Cartmill had three hits for Orfordville to pace all hitters and Evansville's Jon Frey drove in three runs for the Jays.
